When is the establishment of AHAS KIRKHS?

AHAS KIRKHS was first established as the CENTRE FOR FUNDAMENTAL KNOWLEDGE (CFK) in July 1983 with the objective of providing courses in Revealed Knowledge, in line with the Islamization and Integration of the University Curriculum.

The Centre was upgraded to become the Kulliyyah of Islamic Revealed Knowledge and Human Sciences in 1990. Initially, CFK became the Department of Islamic Revealed Knowledge and Heritage, which was then further developed into 4 new departments in December 1996 (Usul al-Din and Comparative Religion, Qur'an and Sunnah Studies, Fiqh & Usul al-Fiqh, and General Studies).

Eight Human Sciences departments were established at the same time which includes Arabic Language and Literature, English Language and Literature, Communication, History, Psychology, Political Science, Sociology and Anthropology, Philosophy, and Library/Information Science.

Why did it change from KIRKHS to AHAS KIRKHS?

AHAS KIRKHS was named after IIUM former second rector, almarhum Professor Emeritus Dato'

Dr. Abdul Hamid Ahmad AbuSulayman, an internationally renowned Islamic scholar, thinker, educator, and author. His significant contribution and impact on the University bring forth enough reason on why Kulliyyah decided to alter its name.

The name was initially proposed by Prof. Emeritus Tan Sri Dr. Mohd Kamal Hassan and was revealed by Prof. Emeritus Tan Sri Dato' Dzulkifli Abdul Razak at the 30th anniversary celebration of AHAS KIRKHS.

On **5th November 2021**, the previously known KIRKHS is now known as AHAS KIRKHS.

Who is AbdulHamid AbuSulayman?

Prof. Emeritus Dato' Dr. Abdul Hamid A. Abu Sulayman is one of the **best known contemporary scholars in the Muslim world**, with vision and commitment for the advancement of the Muslim ummah who. He was born in Mecca in 1936 and died at the age of 85 on August 18, 2021

He served as the **second Rector** of the International Islamic University Malaysia (IIUM) **between 1989 and 1999** where he reformed and performed tremendously in uplifting IIUM to an internationally Muslim hub of higher education. Prof. Abdul Hamid also oversaw the beautiful designs and construction of the university's sprawling campus in Gombak, which was a blend of modern and Islamic architecture.






What are the vision and mission of ALA?






